## LOUISVILLE MAGIC CLUB PICNIC SEPTEMBER 24, 2005

Last year, for the first time, the stage magic, (which starts around 7:45 PM) featured our own LMC members and was the return of our stage contest. It was well received and will be done again this year!

Darrin Pearl aka "Frankie Foolya", has been hard at work organizing this event. Ken Abbott will be master of ceremonies. A panel of judges will grade the performances and the winners will be announced that evening.

There will be prizes and certificates for the top participants. For Seniors (17 years and up), first place will get \$50, second \$35 and third \$25. There will be a first place prize of \$35 for the Juniors. The winners will be awarded their prizes and certificates at the LMC Annual Christmas Banquet, December 3, 2005.

The magicians and their families start gathering from noon on. There will be soft drinks and munchies furnished as you enjoy the view, socialize with others, stroll the dealer tables (if you have any magic to sell, bring what you have and a table to set up shop) and be entertained at the close-up tent.

This year, Matt McKiernan is organizing the close-up program. There will be magic at 2:00, 3:00 and 4:00 PM. On the half hour, starting at 2:30, basic magic will be taught to those interested in learning.

Around 5:00 PM, there will be a catered dinner. The cost will be \$7.00 per person. So that we know how many meals to order, it is necessary to have a reservation. Again the meal is catered so reservations are a must!

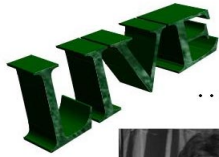

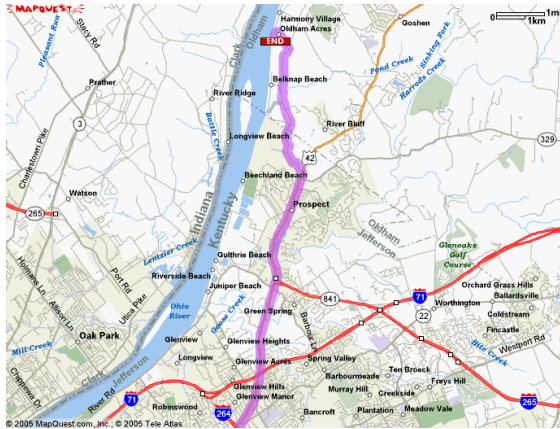
