In 2002, he took first place in London's MacMillan International Magic Convention and amazed the magic world with his Doubled-Hand Matrix and Ninja Rings routines. In March 2003, Magic Magazine featured Shoot on the cover. In the same year, he was awarded "Magician of the Year" in the Close-up Category by the American Academy of Magical Arts. In August 2003, Shoot's biography was published in Japan.

Shoot is a creator and performer of beautiful magic. His original magic has been featured in many magazines and tender through his numerous videos. He's also an advisor/consultant for TV and live events. Shoot is available for television, trade shows, casino shows, corporate events, lectures, and private events. Tips from the Editor

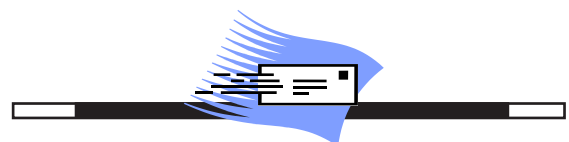
PLEASE, if you'd like an emailed bulletin, send a "subscribe me" e-mail from the e-mail account you will be using so I can put you in the system. I've had several computer and network issues and lost many of the addresses. So I'm backing them up on the website and another place so I will have them. Also Please Let Me Know if you CHANGE YOUR E-MAIL! Each time I send them out, I get several bounced back to me.

Lastly a few notes about submitting articles, if you have info for the bulletin please e-mail it. I can use Microsoft Works, Word, Publisher, Adobe InDesign or PageMaker. If you send it by fax, I have to re-type it all, because the fax will not scan in my OCR software without giving me a lot of errors. Do type in ALL CAPS, I have to retype it if you do.

Photos need to be at least 300 DPI in a tiff or jpeg format, anything else will not reproduce well. Most lecturer pictures I use come from their websites and many are low resolution, but some actually send me high resolution files which makes them look much better!

Following these tips will allow me to get your bulletin completed in a more timely manner.
