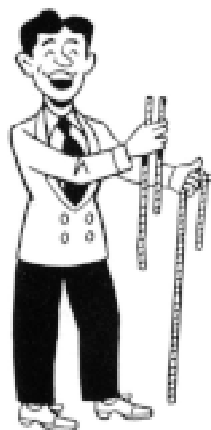

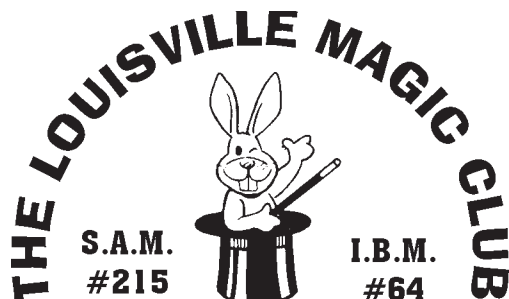

## Hank Moorehouse lecture:

On Thursday, October 12, 2006, the LMC was presented a lecture from Hank Moorehouse. Presenting effects such as the Invisible Ash-tray, Burnt Bill routine and Half Deck, Hank showed us some very useable material.

He also gave us insight into how to develop a stand-up performance that gets results. In Hank's professional performance he does 30 - 40 minutes and only 8 tricks, and six of those use audience members.

Another thing Hank discussed is using children's effects for adult audiences and vice versa by changing the presentation. He used the coloring book as one example, in which the effect was used in a presentation to sales professionals.

Hank is also one of the organizers of the 2008 IBM/SAM convention and told us it will be unlike any event we've ever seen!
