Iroquois Amphitheater Show

Time is drawing near for the September show. We have a great lineup starring Mac King. Information can be gotten at the web site www.LouisvilleMagicShow.com. All ticket must be sold through Ticket Master. If you want to get tickets thru the club you better hurry. Members can become a sponsor for the show for \$60 and they will receive 4 complementary tickets. Members can also buy a 1/8 page ad for \$100. With the \$100 ad they receive 6 complementary tickets. The \$100 ads are for members that are looking to advertise as a magician. The 1/8 page ad is for members only. So get with a buddy and you can split the cost of a sponsorship and the cost of your ticket will only be \$15 per a ticket. Note that if you buy thru Ticket Master your cost will be approximately \$20 each.

We are also looking for commercial sponsors. All ads are full color and art work must be camera ready. Commercial ads for the program start at 1/4 page for \$200 and they receive 8 comp. tickets. A 1/2 page is \$400 and receives 16 comp. tickets. We also have the inside front and back cover for \$1000 for a full page and \$500 for a 1/2 page. Full page receives 36 comps and 1/2 pages receive 16.
